FAQ's

What is Study 101?

Study 101 is designed as a place for Sac High students to complete their homework in a quiet space with specialized tutors (courtesy of City Year, visit www.cityyear.org for more info). This is not a time to play on your phone, talk with friends, or just “hang out” but rather, a chance to knock out your homework and learn some basics about how to study, time management, and excelling academically.

Who can join?

All Sac High students are welcome once they have completed a registration form (attached).

What if I do not have any homework to complete?

In order to maintain a quiet and productive environment for all students in Study 101, we ask that only students who have homework to complete or wish to study participate in Study 101. If you are looking for other activities offered after school, please speak with Ms. Alex.

If I sign up for Study 101 do I have to participate every day?

No. Some days you won't have homework or a test to study for and that's okay. We have other clubs and activities happening on campus that you can jump in and be a part of. Manage your time and schedule wisely so you can choose what days will be best for you to utilize Study 101.

I need help with certain subjects. Is there any support for me in Study 101?

We have the unique opportunity to utilize City Year members as tutors on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays for Study 101. They are recent college graduates who are happy and ready to help with nearly any subject matter.

Will there be food provided?

A snack is provided for students participating in Study 101. It is generally offered an hour after Study 101 has begun.

How long do I have to stay in Study 101 each day?

We want you to use your time wisely while in Study 101. Typically students stay at least one hour in Study 101 completing homework or studying up for a test, however, you are more than welcome to stay longer in order to complete assignments or finish studying. *(PLEASE NOTE: City Year will only be available during the first hour of Study 101 for tutoring)*

What happens once I've completed the first hour of Study 101?

Once you've completed your homework and had a snack you are welcome to go home or participate in another club activity on campus. Again, if you want to stay longer to complete assignments/study, you are welcome to do so. (Please Note: Some clubs and activities may not be available after Study 101, check in with the Advisor or Ms. Alex for information on what is being offered)

Can I be asked to leave Study 101?

Yes. If you, as a student, are a disruption to the learning environment, the Advisor has the right to ask you to leave Study 101. A parent/guardian will be called to discuss why you have been asked to leave and the Program Manager may also make a call to your parent/guardian regarding next steps and future participation in the program.

What if I don't show up to Study 101 on the day my parent has written down (form attached)

If you do not show up to Study 101 on the days your parent/guardian has written down, your parent/guardian will be informed via phone and/or email.

Can I come late to Study 101?

If you arrive late (15 minutes after Study 101 has begun) you will need to provide a note stating where you were (see list below for excused tardies). If you can't produce a note, a parent/guardian will be notified of your tardiness. After 3 unexcused tardies (per semester) a parent conference will be held to determine future participation in Study 101. The Advisor has the right to dismiss students who do not follow the rules, regulations, and expectations outlined in this packet.
