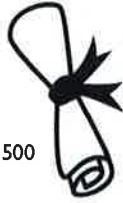

*Following this event, scholars will return to their regular class schedule for the rest of the day.*



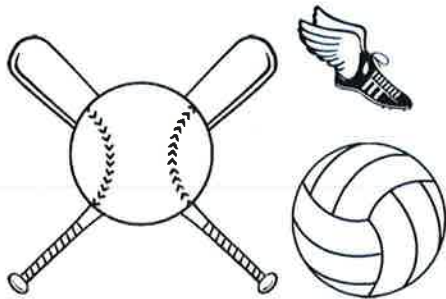
