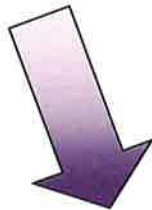

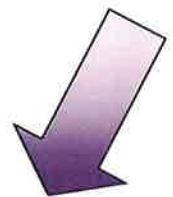

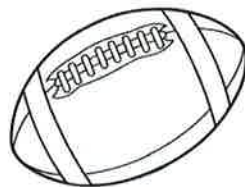
Parent Financial Aid Info Night
