

Dear St. HOPE Class of 2020 Scholars and Families,

Congratulations on making it to the end of your last quarter as a high school scholar! We only have 2.5 weeks left of this school year! You are so close to officially concluding your high school career and transitioning to the next chapter in your adventure! We have been working hard as a team to get creative under these situations and plan an end-of-year graduation celebration that we hope is meaningful for each and every one of you. I am excited to be able to share the details of our end-of-year events in this letter!

SIGNING DAY- Thank you to many of you that have created and submitted short videos of yourself declaring the college you will be matriculating to in the fall! We are in the process of compiling these videos to make a tribute to all of you and your accomplishments on making it to college! This video will be shared with you on our regularly scheduled signing day on Friday, May 29th!

CAP AND GOWN PICKUP- On Wednesday, May 27th from 10:00am-12:00pm we will be hosting our annual Cap and Gown pick-up. On this day all scholars are invited to come to the front of Sacramento Charter High School in their vehicles to pick up their Cap and Gown. We will also be turning this into a pre-graduation celebration! We invite you all to add decorations to your cars in the spirit of celebrating your forthcoming graduation, similar to the way you would deck out your cap and gown. We will be having a friendly competition and giving three prizes out for the top three decorated vehicles! You will pull up to the front of Sac High, entering off of Y Street and staff members will be there to deliver your materials to you. In addition to receiving your Cap and Gown, we have a personalized surprise gift that we are very excited to give to each of you! Jostens will also be present with a limited supply of caps and gowns in case you have any last-minute purchases to make! GRADUATION- We are going to be pre-filming our graduation ceremony and pushing it out to our families at our regularly scheduled time on Saturday, June 6th at 7:30pm. In planning for this, it was really important for us to preserve the traditional rite of passage of graduates crossing the stage and receiving their diploma. We are going to invite scholars to come to The Guild Theater in Oak Park at a specific date and time with their advisory. This will ensure that scholars remain in small groups of only 9-16 scholars. We will then have scholars participate in a mini portion of the ceremony where their name will be called, they will cross the stage, receive their diploma and take their graduation cap and gown photo. We will be putting together the different portions of our filming to create a fluid ceremony. Then, you will be able to enjoy watching the ceremony and celebrating your scholar from the comfort and safety of your home! We will ensure that proper cleaning and sanitization will take place and that social distancing is maintained the entire time in The Guild Theater. If for any reason you do not feel comfortable participating, please know that this is optional and we respect your decision.

Please see below for the time and date for your specific Advisory. I cannot emphasize enough how important it is for you to be on time so that you do not miss your opportunity. We do not have room to run behind as we need to complete each advisory before beginning the next so that we are very careful with minimizing the amount of individuals that will be present inside The Guild Theater at the same time. Families or additional individuals are not permitted inside The Guild Theater. The only individuals inside will be the scholars from one advisory and a small group of Sacramento Charter High School staff. Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate additional individuals as we must keep the number of individuals to as few as possible to ensure we are following social distancing protocols. - Jeans
- T-shirts
- Flip flops (shoes MUST have a back)

Females:

- Dress/skirt OR slacks and dress shirt
- Appropriate hosiery
- Dress shoes

GRADUATION VIDEO- As you know, last Monday, May 11th, we put out a request to our Senior Class to film a video of themselves doing a little dance. This video is a Sac High tradition and always plays at the conclusion of our graduation ceremony. **These videos as well as the baby pictures are now past due. Please submit by Thursday, May 21st or we unfortunately will not be able to include you in the video as we must begin the editing process to finish in time.** I'm including the directions for the video again.



Then and Now Video for Graduation Directions:

- 1. Background: Stand in front of a solid background.
- 2. In Frame: Scholar from the waist up and solid background only. It is important that you are recording from a distance that only captures your waist and up so that your body fills the frame more than your surrounding does.
- 3. Lighting: Have lighting in front of you, not behind you. Your friends and family want to see YOU, not a huge glare.
- 4. Attire: Professional Dress, College wear, or Class of 2020 Shirt (yes, you <u>will</u> need to reshoot your video if your attire doesn't follow these guidelines).
- 5. What to record: Be <u>proud</u>, smile, do a little dance, strike a few poses or wave to your family and friends through the camera. **Your video needs to be** <u>6 seconds</u> **long!** Note: There will be music playing over these videos instead of the recorded audio.
- 6. Save Video and email to **aperez@sachigh.org** with your full first and last name.
- 7. Check back in your email after sending me your video. I will let you know that it was received or if you need to reshoot.
