Presence

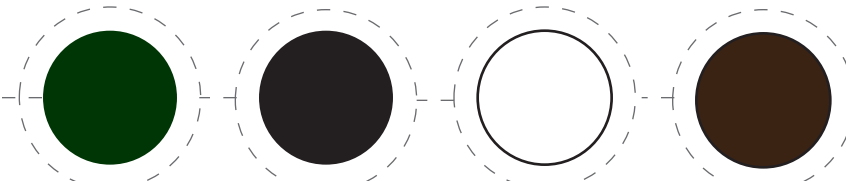
Our appearance makes a statement. We dress in a neat and professional manner so we can present the best of ourselves and our school to the rest of the world.

Community

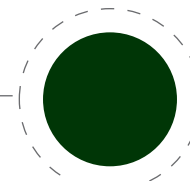
The uniform symbolizes a shared commitment to our education and shows that we are a part of something bigger: one school, one community, one family.

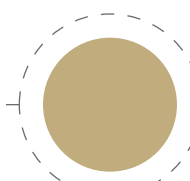

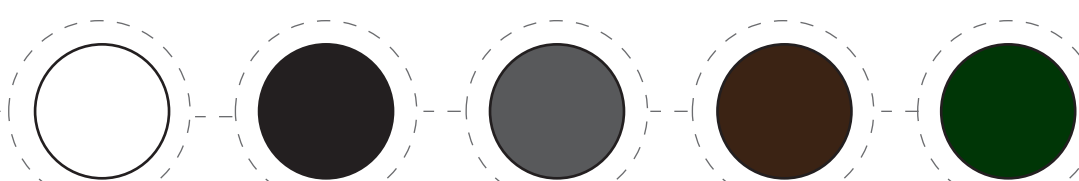

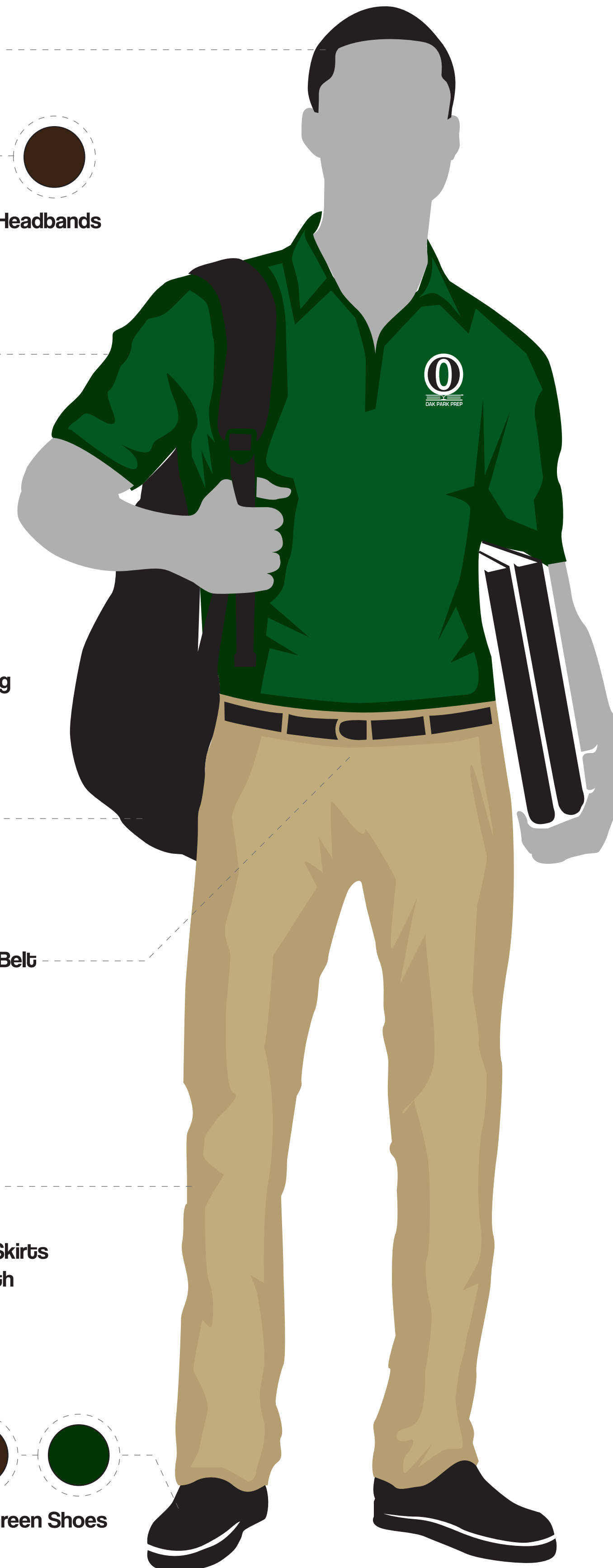
